- Tents were put up so we could have camp meetings! For family camp we were able to put up the dining tent at the kitchen – thanks to Dave and the skid steer moving and packing fill and Adrian tamping fill and covering the pony wall, plus ...!
- Great ministry at all our camp meetings with His presence evident at the services and campfires. People's lives were changed, saved, renewed and baptized! The many jobs that needed doing were done by willing volunteers with joy in their hearts that they could serve God and had the ability and health to work! We had cooks, bakers, dish washers, bathroom cleaners, garbage handler's, canteen workers, maintenance workers, worship leaders, musicians, teachers, preachers, prayer team, attendees and others that all worked together to make the ministry happen!

- We were able to get a permit to open the channel into the marina.
- We had a lot of volunteers come to help with their chain saws and heavy equipment to prepare the grounds for building and make it safer.
- God provided an engineer at a very reasonable cost, when we needed an engineered drawing for the tall wall facing the lake. We had been delayed with starting the building because the first engineer would not sign off on his drawing for the tall wall.
- Finally, having worked out all the kinks, the building inspector gave us the go ahead to begin building. So on September 27, Kadrian Construction was able to begin building the Chapel/Dining Hall!
- We now have the mezzanine floor sheeted and material for the tall wall came today.
- We are expecting the arrival of the roof system very soon.
- God has blessed us with great weather this fall to do the building!
- We are excited to welcome Bruce and Pam Kashuba as camp staff. They will move here soon and will help in all areas of this ministry.

Prayer requests:

- Good weather to close in the chapel/dining hall before the snow comes.
- Finances for running the camp and continuing building the chapel/dining. After our Fundraiser on April 1 we had 103,238.19 to work with for building. When the bills all come in we will have spent about \$74,537.24 on material for building (including roof system), engineer, pony wall and footings and other associated costs.
- Safety for the workers who are building and doing various jobs around camp.
- Volunteers to help with building, making firewood, cleaning up underbrush and roots, trees, and lots of other stuff!
- For Bruce and Pam, as they down size (selling stuff) and prepare to move.

We want to express thanks to God for his faithfulness. We thank each one of you who pray for Wilderness Ministries Bible Camp, who support us with your finances and equipment and who volunteer of your time. Without all this support we would not be here.
